

# **STALLION LICENSING REQUIREMENTS**

## 3 year old Stallions

- With appropriate inspection scores, entered into Stud Book I
- To maintain Stud Book I licensing –
  - Return DNA & Veterinary Certificate within 30 days
  - Successfully complete 30-day test within 18 months
  - Meet performance requirements or successfully complete 70-day test by the end of their 6<sup>th</sup> year

## 4 year old Stallions

- With appropriate inspection scores, entered into Stud Book I
- To maintain Stud Book I licensing –
  - Return DNA & Veterinary Certificate within 30 days
  - Successfully complete 30-day test within 6 months
  - Meet performance requirements or successfully complete 70-day test by the end of their 6<sup>th</sup> year

## 5/6 year old Stallions

- With appropriate inspection scores, successful 30-day test, and appropriate performance results or successful 70-day test, entered into Stud Book I
  - To maintain Stud Book I licensing –
    - Return DNA & Veterinary Certificate within 30 days
    - Present documentation of 30-day test scores and proof of performance requirements at inspection
- With appropriate inspection scores, entered into Stud Book II
  - To upgrade to Stud Book I –
    - Return DNA & Veterinary Certificate within 30 days
    - Complete 30-day test within 6 months
    - Meet performance requirements or successfully complete 70-day test by the end of their 6<sup>th</sup> year

## 7 year old and older Stallions

- With appropriate inspection scores and appropriate PRIOR test and/or performance results, entered into Stud Book I
  - To maintain Stud Book I licensing –
    - Return DNA & Veterinary Certificate within 30 days
    - Present documentation of proof of prior test and performance requirements at inspection (30-day test plus 5 or 6 year old performance results, 30 day test plus 70 day test, or older stallion performance results)

## Thoroughbred Stallions

- Money earned of \$100,000 or greater and/or stakes wins

## STALLION PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

Stallions must complete one of the following -

### 5 Year Old

- JUMPING – M level / 1.20 m / 4'0" / Level 5 / 5 year old Young Jumpers
  - 3 double clear rounds at an USEF sanctioned "A" rated show in the Level 5 divisionOR
  - Qualify for the 5 year old Young Jumpers League finals
- DRESSAGE – M level / 2<sup>nd</sup> level / 5 year old FEI
  - 3 scores of 65% or higher at 2<sup>nd</sup> Level at a USDF sanctioned showOR
  - Qualify for the 5 year old FEI Young Horse Championship with an overall score of 8.0 or higher
- EVENTING – 5 year old Young Event Horse
  - Qualify for the 5 year old Young Event Horse Championship with a 75% or higher at two or more competitions sanctioned by USEA
- HUNTERS – First Year Green / Green Conformation / 3'6"
  - Top 10% of division for year-end national points in either First Year Green or Green Conformation divisions

### 6 Year Old

- JUMPING – Z level / 1.30 m / 4'3" / Level 6 / 6 year old Young Jumpers
  - 3 double clear rounds at an USEF sanctioned "A" rated show in the Level 6 divisionOR
  - Qualify for the 6 year old Young Jumpers League finals
- DRESSAGE – Z level / 3<sup>rd</sup> level / 6 year old FEI
  - 3 scores of 65% or higher at 3<sup>rd</sup> Level at a USDF sanctioned showOR
  - Qualify for the 6 year old FEI Young Horse Championship with an overall score of 8.0 or higher
- HUNTERS – Second Year Green / Green Conformation / 3'9"
  - Top 10% of division for year-end national points in either Second Year Green or Green Conformation divisions

### Older Stallions

- JUMPING – ZZ level / 1.40 m / 4'6" / Level 7
  - 5 placings of 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> at an USEF sanctioned "A" rated show in the Level 7 division
- DRESSAGE – ZZZ level / Prix St. Georges
  - 5 placings of 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> with scores of 60% or higher at Prix St. Georges at a USDF sanctioned show
- EVENTING – Intermediate
  - 5 placings of 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Intermediate level at an USEA sanctioned show
- HUNTERS – Working / Conformation / 4'
  - Top 10% of division for year-end national points in either Working or Regular Conformation divisions
